5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 408, Labor Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 408.0295 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 408.0295. SURGICAL ASSISTANT SERVICES. (a) Ar
8	insurance carrier may not refuse to reimburse a health care
9	practitioner solely because the practitioner is a surgical
10	assistant licensed under Chapter 206, Occupations Code, or a
11	surgical first assistant certified by a national certifying
12	organization approved by the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners
13	for a covered service that a physician providing health care

- (b) A surgical assistant described by this section shall be reimbursed on the same basis as a physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist who functions as a first assistant in surgery.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date that the compensable injury occurred, and

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
