amended by adding Sections 531.078 through 531.082 to read as

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9 Sec. 531.078. QUALITY ASSURANCE FEES ON CERTAIN WAIVER
10 PROGRAM SERVICES. (a) In this section, "gross receipts" means
11 money received as compensation for services under an intermediate
12 care facilities for the mentally retarded waiver program such as a
13 home and community services waiver or a community living assistance
14 and support services waiver. The term does not include a charitable
15 contribution, revenues received for services or goods other than

waivers, or any money received from consumers or their families as

reimbursement for services or goods not normally covered by the

18 waivers.

19 <u>(b) The executive commissioner by rule shall modify the</u>

20 quality assurance fee program under Subchapter H, Chapter 252,

Health and Safety Code, by providing for a quality assurance fee

22 program that imposes a quality assurance fee on persons providing

services under a home and community services waiver or a community

living assistance and support services waiver.

- 1 (c) The executive commissioner shall establish the fee at an amount that will produce annual revenues of not more than six
- 3 percent of the total annual gross receipts in this state.
- 4 (d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules governing:
- 5 (1) the reporting required to compute and collect the 6 fee and the manner and times of collecting the fee; and
- 7 (2) the administration of the fee, including the 8 imposition of penalties for a violation of the rules.
- 9 <u>(e) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited in</u>
  10 the waiver program quality assurance fee account.
- 11 Sec. 531.079. WAIVER PROGRAM QUALITY ASSURANCE FEE ACCOUNT.
- 12 (a) The waiver program quality assurance fee account is a
- 13 dedicated account in the general revenue fund. The account is
- exempt from the application of Section 403.095. Interest earned on
- money in the account shall be credited to the account.
- 16 (b) The account consists of fees collected under Section
- 17 <u>531.078</u> and interest earned on money in the account.
- (c) Subject to legislative appropriation and state and
- 19 federal law, money in the account may be appropriated only to the
- 20 Department of Aging and Disability Services to increase
- 21 reimbursement rates paid under the home and community services
- 22 <u>waiver program or the community living assistance and support</u>
- 23 services waiver program or to offset allowable expenses under the
- 24 state Medicaid program.
- Sec. 531.080. REIMBURSEMENT OF WAIVER PROGRAMS. Subject to
- legislative appropriation and state and federal law, the Department
- 27 of Aging and Disability Services shall use money from the waiver

- 1 program quality assurance fee account, together with any federal
- 2 money available to match money from the account, to increase
- 3 reimbursement rates paid under the home and community services
- 4 waiver program or the community living assistance and support
- 5 services waiver program.
- 6 Sec. 531.081. INVALIDITY; FEDERAL FUNDS. If any portion of
- 7 Sections 531.078-531.080 is held invalid by a final order of a court
- 8 that is not subject to appeal, or if the commission determines that
- 9 the imposition of the quality assurance fee and the expenditure of
- 10 the money collected as provided by those sections will not entitle
- 11 this state to receive additional federal money under the Medicaid
- 12 program, the commission shall:
- 13 (1) stop collection of the quality assurance fee; and
- 14 (2) not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 15 collection of the quality assurance fee is stopped, return any
- money collected under Section 531.078, but not spent under Section
- 17 531.080, to the persons who paid the fees in proportion to the total
- 18 amount paid by those persons.
- 19 Sec. 531.082. EXPIRATION OF QUALITY ASSURANCE FEE ON WAIVER
- 20 PROGRAMS. If Subchapter H, Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code,
- 21 expires, this section and Sections 531.078-531.081 expire on the
- 22 same date.
- 23 SECTION 2. Section 252.209, Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 repealed.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
