1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the expansion of the East Medina County Special Utility
1-9 District and the composition of the district's board of directors.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
1-12 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7203 to read as follows:

1-13 CHAPTER 7203. EAST MEDINA COUNTY SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT

1-14 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1-15 Sec. 7203.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

1-16 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
1-17 district.

1-18 (2) "Director" means a member of the board.

1-19 (3) "District" means the East Medina County Special
1-20 Utility District.

1-21 Sec. 7203.002. DISTRICT TERRITORY. The district's
1-22 boundaries are coextensive with the boundaries of the territory
1-23 that is described by certificate of convenience and necessity
1-24 number 10217.

1-25 [Sections 7203.003-7203.050 reserved for expansion]

1-26 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1-27 Sec. 7203.051. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. The board consists of
1-28 seven directors.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
