11	Sec. 8131.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

17	Sec. 8131.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
18	municipal utility district in Galveston County created under and
19	essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 52, Article III,
20	and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
21	Sec. 8131.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the
22	creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation
23	election held under Section 8131.023 before September 1, 2009:
24	(1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2009,

On the uniform 19 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate 20 21 number of directors shall be elected. 22 [Sections 8131.053-8131.100 reserved for expansion] SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 23 Sec. 8131.101. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the 24 rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties 25 26 provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 27 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created

2	Sec. 8131.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) To the extent authorized
3	by Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
4	construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized,

6	those roads or turnpikes, inside the district.
7	(b) A road project must meet all applicable construction
8	standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulatory
9	ordinances of the municipality or county in whose jurisdiction the

copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code.

5 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 6 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 7 Environmental Quality.

8 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 9 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 10 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 11 representatives within the required time.

12 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 13 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 14 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 15 and accomplished.
