1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the creation of the Galveston County Municipal Utility  
1-11 District No. 53; providing authority to impose a tax and issue  
1-12 bonds; granting the power of eminent domain.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws  
1-15 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8131 to read as follows:

1-16 CHAPTER 8131. GALVESTON COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT  
1-17 NO. 53

1-18 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1-19 Sec. 8131.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

1-20 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the  
1-21 district.

1-22 (2) "Director" means a member of the board.

1-23 (3) "District" means the Galveston County Municipal  
1-24 Utility District No. 53.

1-25 Sec. 8131.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a  
1-26 municipal utility district in Galveston County created under and  
1-27 essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 52, Article III,  
1-28 and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

1-29 Sec. 8131.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the  
1-30 creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation  
1-31 election held under Section 8131.023 before September 1, 2009:

1-32 (1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2009,  
1-33 except that:

1-34 (A) any debts incurred shall be paid;

1-35 (B) any assets that remain after the payment of  
1-36 debts shall be transferred to Galveston County; and

1-37 (C) the organization of the district shall be  
1-38 maintained until all debts are paid and remaining assets are  
1-39 transferred; and

1-40 (2) this chapter expires September 1, 2010.

1-41 Sec. 8131.004. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The  
1-42 district is initially composed of the territory described by  
1-43 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

1-44 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of  
1-45 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the  
1-46 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process  
1-47 does not affect:

1-48 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the  
1-49 district;

1-50 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes;

1-51 (3) the validity of the district's bonds, notes, or  
1-52 indebtedness; or

1-53 (4) the legality or operation of the district or the  
1-54 board.

1-55 Sec. 8131.005. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Except as  
1-56 otherwise provided by this chapter, Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,  
1-57 apply to the district.

1-59 SUBCHAPTER A1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONS

1-60 Sec. 8131.021. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after  
1-61 September 1, 2005, a person who owns land inside the boundaries of  
1-62 the proposed district may petition the Texas Commission on  
1-63 Environmental Quality to appoint as temporary directors the five

2-1 persons listed in the petition.

2-2 (b) The commission shall appoint as temporary directors the  
2-3 persons listed in a petition received by the commission under  
2-4 Subsection (a). If the commission receives more than one petition,  
2-5 the commission shall appoint the directors listed in the first  
2-6 petition the commission receives.

2-7 (c) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the  
2-8 commission shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy.

2-9 (d) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

2-10 (1) the date directors are elected under Section  
2-11 8131.023; or

2-12 (2) the date this chapter expires under Section  
2-13 8131.003.

2-14 Sec. 8131.022. ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF TEMPORARY  
2-15 DIRECTORS. As soon as practicable after all the temporary  
2-16 directors have qualified under Section 49.055, Water Code, the  
2-17 temporary directors shall meet at a location in the district  
2-18 agreeable to a majority of the directors. If a location cannot be  
2-19 agreed upon, the meeting shall be at the Galveston County  
2-20 Courthouse. At the meeting, the temporary directors shall elect  
2-21 officers from among the temporary directors and conduct any other  
2-22 district business.

2-23 Sec. 8131.023. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS'  
2-24 ELECTION. The temporary directors shall hold an election to  
2-25 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five directors as  
2-26 provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2-27 Sec. 8131.024. INITIAL ELECTED DIRECTORS; TERMS. The  
2-28 directors elected under Section 8131.023 shall draw lots to  
2-29 determine which two shall serve terms expiring June 1 following the  
2-30 first regularly scheduled election of directors under Section  
2-31 8131.052 and which three shall serve until June 1 following the  
2-32 second regularly scheduled election of directors.

2-33 Sec. 8131.025. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter  
2-34 expires September 1, 2010.

2-35 [Sections 8131.026-8131.050 reserved for expansion]

2-36 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

2-37 Sec. 8131.051. DIRECTORS; TERMS. (a) The district is  
2-38 governed by a board of five directors.

2-39 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms that expire  
2-40 June 1 of even-numbered years.

2-41 Sec. 8131.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform  
2-42 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate  
2-43 number of directors shall be elected.

2-44 [Sections 8131.053-8131.100 reserved for expansion]

2-45 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

2-46 Sec. 8131.101. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the  
2-47 rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties  
2-48 provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and  
2-49 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created  
2-50 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

2-51 Sec. 8131.102. ROAD PROJECTS. The district may construct,  
2-52 acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized, graveled, or  
2-53 paved roads or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of those roads or  
2-54 turnpikes, inside or outside the district.

2-55 Sec. 8131.103. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT  
2-56 ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS. Subject to the limitations of Section  
2-57 54.016, Water Code, the district shall comply with all applicable  
2-58 requirements of any ordinance or resolution adopted by the city  
2-59 council of the City of Texas City, including an ordinance or  
2-60 resolution adopted before September 1, 2005, that consents to the  
2-61 creation of the district or to the inclusion of lands within the  
2-62 district.

2-63 [Sections 8131.104-8131.150 reserved for expansion]

2-64 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

2-65 Sec. 8131.151. TAX TO REPAY BONDS. The district may impose  
2-66 a tax to pay the principal of or interest on bonds issued under  
2-67 Section 8131.201.

2-68 Sec. 8131.152. UTILITY EXEMPTION FROM IMPACT FEES AND  
2-69 ASSESSMENTS. The district may not impose an impact fee or

- 3-1 assessment on the property, equipment, rights-of-way, facilities,
- 3-2 or improvements of:
- 3-3 (1) an electric utility as defined by Section 31.002,
- 3-4 Utilities Code;
- 3-5 (2) a gas utility as defined by Section 101.003 or
- 3-6 121.001, Utilities Code;
- 3-7 (3) a telecommunications provider as defined by
- 3-8 Section 51.002, Utilities Code; or
- 3-9 (4) a cable operator as defined by 47 U.S.C. Section
- 3-10 522.

SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

Sec. 8131.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other obligations as provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to finance the construction, maintenance, or operation of projects under Sections 8131.101 and 8131.102.

(b) The district may not issue bonds to finance projects authorized by Section 8131.102 unless the issuance is approved by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the voters of the district voting at an election called for that purpose.

(c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance projects authorized by Section 8131.102 may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

(d) Sections 49.181 and 49.182, Water Code, do not apply to a project undertaken by a district under Section 8131.102 or to bonds issued by the district to finance the project.

SECTION 2. The Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 53 initially includes all the territory contained in the following area:

6-28       SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
6-29 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
6-30 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
6-31 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
6-32 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
6-33 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
6-34 Government Code.

6-35       (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
6-36 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
6-37 Environmental Quality.

6-38       (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
6-39 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
6-40 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
6-41 representatives within the required time.

6-42       (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
6-43 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
6-44 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
6-45 and accomplished.

6-46       SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
