

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of the Fort Bend County Municipal Utility
3 District No. 167; providing authority to impose taxes and issue
4 bonds; granting the power of eminent domain.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8142 to read as follows:

8 CHAPTER 8142. FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

9 NO. 167

10 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

11 Sec. 8142.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

12 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
13 district.

14 (2) "City" means the City of Rosenberg, Texas.

15 (3) "County" means Fort Bend County.

16 (4) "Director" means a member of the board.

17 (5) "District" means the Fort Bend County Municipal
18 Utility District No. 167.

19 Sec. 8142.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
20 municipal utility district in Fort Bend County created under and
21 essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI,
22 Texas Constitution.

23 Sec. 8142.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. The board
24 shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district as

1 provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2 Sec. 8142.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE.

3 (a) All land and other property included in the district will
4 benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the
5 district under powers conferred by Section 52, Article III, and
6 Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

7 (b) The district is created to accomplish:

8 (1) the same purposes as a municipal utility district
9 as provided by Section 54.012, Water Code; and

10 (2) the construction, acquisition, improvement,
11 maintenance, or operation of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads
12 or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of those roads or turnpikes, to
13 the extent authorized by Section 52, Article III, Texas
14 Constitution.

15 Sec. 8142.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
16 district is initially composed of the territory described by
17 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

18 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
19 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
20 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
21 does not affect the district's:

22 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

23 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
24 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
25 interest on a bond;

26 (3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or

27 (4) legality or operation.

2 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

3 Sec. 8142.051. DIRECTORS; TERMS. (a) The district is
4 governed by a board of five directors.

5 (b) Except as provided by Section 8142.053, directors serve
6 staggered four-year terms.

7 Sec. 8142.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform
8 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate
9 number of directors shall be elected.

10 Sec. 8142.053. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board
11 consists of:

12 (1) Lisa Prejean;

13 (2) Yvonne Cummins;

14 (3) James Swanson;

15 (4) Deana Day; and

16 (5) Jerry Schultza.

17 (b) The terms of the first three directors named in
18 Subsection (a) expire on the uniform election date in May of 2006,
19 and the terms of the last two directors named in Subsection (a)
20 expire on the uniform election date in May of 2008.

21 (c) This section expires September 1, 2009.

23 SUBCHAPTER C. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES

24 Sec. 8142.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
25 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
26 which the district is created.

27 Sec. 8142.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND

1 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
2 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
3 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
4 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

5 Sec. 8142.103. ROAD PROJECTS. The district may construct,
6 acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized, graveled, or
7 paved roads or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of those roads or
8 turnpikes, inside the district.

9 Sec. 8142.104. MUNICIPAL OR COUNTY CONSENT AND STANDARDS.

10 (a) The district may not undertake a road project unless each
11 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
12 jurisdiction the district is located consents by ordinance or
13 resolution. If the district is located outside the
14 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the district may
15 not undertake a road project unless each county in which the
16 district is located consents by ordinance or resolution.

17 (b) A road project must meet all applicable construction
18 standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulatory
19 ordinances of each municipality in whose corporate limits or
20 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located. If the
21 district is located outside the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
22 municipality, a road project must meet all applicable construction
23 standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulatory
24 ordinances of each county in which the district is located.

25 Sec. 8142.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
26 ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS. Subject to the limitations of Section
27 54.016, Water Code, the district shall comply with all applicable

1 requirements of any ordinance or resolution adopted by the city
2 council of the City of Rosenberg that consents to the creation of
3 the district or to the inclusion of lands within the district.

4 Sec. 8142.106. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. The
5 district may exercise the power of eminent domain outside the
6 district only to acquire an easement necessary for underground
7 water, sewage, or drainage facilities that serve the district.

9 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

10 Sec. 8142.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS.

11 (a) The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
12 obligations secured by revenue or contract payments from any lawful
13 source other than ad valorem taxation.

14 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner
15 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
16 before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue bonds
17 payable from ad valorem taxes.

18 Sec. 8142.152. AD VALOREM TAX. (a) If authorized at an
19 election held under Section 8142.151, the district may impose an
20 annual ad valorem tax on taxable property in the district for the
21 provision of services or for the maintenance and operation of the
22 district, including the improvements constructed or acquired by the
23 district.

24 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
25 exceed the rate approved at the election.

1 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

2 Sec. 8142.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
3 OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other
4 obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact
5 fees, revenue, grants, or other district money, or any combination
6 of those sources, to pay for any authorized district purpose.

7 (b) In exercising the district's borrowing power, the
8 district may issue a bond or other obligation in the form of a bond,
9 note, certificate of participation, or other instrument evidencing
10 a proportionate interest in payments to be made by the district, or
11 other type of obligation.

12 (c) The district may not issue bonds to finance projects
13 authorized by Section 8142.103 unless the issuance is approved by a
14 vote of a two-thirds majority of the voters of the district voting
15 at an election called for that purpose.

16 (d) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance
17 projects authorized by Section 8142.103 may not exceed one-fourth
18 of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

19 Sec. 8142.202. TAXES FOR BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. At
20 the time bonds or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad
21 valorem taxes are issued:

22 (1) the board shall impose a continuing direct annual
23 ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, for each year
24 that all or part of the bonds are outstanding; and

25 (2) the district annually shall impose an ad valorem
26 tax on all taxable property in the district in an amount sufficient
27 to:

1 (A) pay the interest on the bonds or other
2 obligations as the interest becomes due;

3 (B) create a sinking fund for the payment of the
4 principal of the bonds or other obligations when due or the
5 redemption price at any earlier required redemption date; and

6 (C) pay the expenses of imposing the taxes.

7 Sec. 8142.203. CERTAIN AUTHORITY OF TEXAS COMMISSION ON
8 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY NOT APPLICABLE. Sections 49.181 and 49.182,
9 Water Code, do not apply to a road project undertaken by the
10 district or to bonds issued by the district to finance the project.
