- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 1075, Acts of the 75th Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 1997, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 3A. ADDITIONAL TERRITORY. In addition to the portions
- 9 of Culberson County included in the boundaries of the district on
- 10 August 31, 2005, the boundaries of the district include all of the
- 11 remain<u>ing territory in Culberson County.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) The annexation under Section 3A, Chapter
- 13 1075, Acts of the 75th Legislature, Regular Session, 1997, as added
- 14 by this Act, of the additional territory in Culberson County that
- 15 was not included in the boundaries of the Culberson County
- 16 Groundwater Conservation District on August 31, 2005, is subject to
- 17 ratification at an election held under Section 36.328, Water Code,
- and this section in which only the voters residing in the territory
- 19 to be annexed are eligible to vote.
- 20 (b) The board of directors of the Culberson County
- 21 Groundwater Conservation District shall hold the ratification
- 22 election on the first uniform election date that occurs after the
- 23 effective date of this Act that allows for compliance with the time
- 24 requirements of the Election Code.

- 1 (c) If a majority of the voters voting at the ratification
- 2 election vote in favor of the annexation, the Culberson County
- 3 Groundwater Conservation District boundaries include all of
- 4 Culberson County.
- 5 (d) If a majority of the voters voting at the ratification
- 6 election do not vote in favor of the annexation, the Culberson
- 7 County Groundwater Conservation District boundaries are unchanged
- 8 and this Act expires.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
