A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the issuance of
- 2 additional general obligation bonds by the Texas Water Development
- 3 Board.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 49-d-10 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 49-d-10. (a) The Texas Water Development Board may
- 8 issue additional general obligation bonds, at its determination,
- 9 for one or more accounts of the Texas Water Development Fund II, in
- 10 an amount not to exceed \$2 billion. Of the additional general
- obligation bonds authorized to be issued, \$500 million of those
- bonds shall be used to provide for subsidized loans and grants for
- 13 wholesale and retail water and wastewater facilities to
- 14 economically distressed areas of the state, as defined by law, to be
- provided on such terms as may be determined by the Texas Water
- 16 Development Board, and shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 17 account established in the Texas Water Development Fund II under
- 18 Section 49-d-8 of this article for the purpose of administering
- 19 proceedings related to the purposes described by Section 49-d-7(b)
- 20 <u>of this article.</u>
- 21 (b) Section 49-d-8 of this article applies to the bonds
- 22 <u>authorized by this section. The limitation in Section 49-d-8 of</u>
- 23 this article that the Texas Water Development Board may not issue
- 24 bonds in excess of the aggregate principal amount of previously

- 1 authorized bonds does not apply to the bonds authorized by and
- 2 <u>issued under this section.</u>
- 3 (c) A limitation on the percentage of state participation in
- 4 any single project imposed by this article does not apply to a
- 5 project funded with the proceeds of bonds issued under the
- 6 <u>authority of this section</u>.
- 7 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- issuance of additional general obligation bonds by the Texas Water
- 12 Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$2 billion."
