BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 40, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is 5 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 7 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), as provided by the 8 legislature, an officer of a municipal utility district may serve 9 as an election judge. SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 10 11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005. 12 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the 13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow an officer of

14 a municipal utility district to simultaneously serve as an election 15 judge."
