A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a county to impose
- 2 a local tax on the sale of gasoline and to transfer the revenue from
- 3 the tax to another political subdivision of this state.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6 adding Section 52j to read as follows:
- Sec. 52j. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution, the legislature by general law may:
- 9 (1) authorize a county to enact a local tax on the sale
- of gasoline in the county and to transfer the tax revenue to another

 political subdivision of this state in which the county is located
- 12 or to which the county is adjacent for use by the political
- 13 subdivision for transportation projects; and
- 14 (2) prescribe the transportation projects for which
- 15 the revenue may be used.
- (b) Section 7-a, Article VIII, of this constitution does not
- apply to a tax authorized by this section.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a county to
- 22 impose a local tax on the sale of gasoline and to transfer the
- 23 revenue from the tax to another political subdivision of this
- 24 state."
