## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the operation of

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (f) and
- 8 (g) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 10 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 11 Subsections (b), (d), [and] (e), and (f) of this section.
- 12 (f) The Legislature by general law may authorize a person
- 13 <u>licensed</u> by the State for that purpose to operate video lottery
- 14 games on behalf of the State as a form of lottery authorized by
- 15 Subsection (e) of this section in counties or municipalities in
- 16 which the voters have approved the operation of the games.
- (g) For purposes of Subsection (f) of this section, "video
- 18 <u>lottery game" means a game of chance that may be played for</u>
- 19 consideration by an individual on an electronic machine or video
- 20 display and in which the player may win a thing of value each time
- the game is played.
- 22 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
