A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize this state to
- 2 license persons to conduct certain electronic gaming on cruise
- 3 vessels departing from or returning to a dock in this state.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 47-a to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 47-a. (a) In addition to any lottery or gift
- 8 enterprise authorized by Section 47 of this article, the
- 9 legislature by general law may authorize this state to license a
- 10 person to conduct electronic gaming on a ship or other watercraft
- 11 that is departing from or returning to a dock in this state on a
- 12 <u>cruise.</u>
- 13 (b) In this section, "electronic gaming" means a game based
- 14 primarily on chance that is played for consideration by an
- 15 individual on an electronic machine or video display and in which
- 16 the player may win a thing of value each time the game is played.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing this state
- 21 to license persons to conduct certain electronic gaming on cruise
- vessels departing from or returning to a dock in this state."
