## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize this state to license persons to conduct certain electronic gaming on cruise vessels departing from or returning to a dock in this state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Section 47-a to read as follows:

Sec. 47-a. (a) In addition to any lottery or gift enterprise authorized by Section 47 of this article, the legislature by general law may authorize this state to license a person to conduct electronic gaming on a ship or other watercraft that is departing from or returning to a dock in this state on a cruise.
(b) In this section, "electronic gaming" means a game based primarily on chance that is played for consideration by an individual on an electronic machine or video display and in which the player may win a thing of value each time the game is played.

SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005 . The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing this state to license persons to conduct certain electronic gaming on cruise vessels departing from or returning to a dock in this state."
