## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the issuance of
- 2 additional obligations to provide financial assistance to counties
- 3 for roadways to serve border colonias.

Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 49-1, Article III, Texas
- 7 (a) To fund financial assistance to counties for roadways to
- 8 serve border colonias, the legislature by general law may authorize
- 9 the governor to authorize the Texas Public Finance Authority or its
- 10 successor to issue general obligation bonds or notes of the State of
- 11 Texas in an aggregate amount not to exceed  $\frac{$600.9}{}$  [\$175] million and
- 12 to enter into related credit agreements. Except as provided by
- 13 Subsection (c) of this section, the proceeds from the sale of the
- 14 bonds and notes may be used only to provide financial assistance to
- counties for border colonia roadway projects, including projects to
- 16 provide access roads to connect border colonias with public roads
- 17 outside the colonias. Projects may include the construction of
- 18 colonia <u>roads and</u> access roads, the acquisition of materials used
- in maintaining colonia roads and access roads, and projects related
- 20 to the construction of colonia roads and access roads, such as
- 21 projects for the drainage of the roads.
- 22 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 24 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
