A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 18, Article V, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Subsections (g) and (i) to read as follows:
- 6 <u>(g) The justices of the peace elected in a county shall</u> 7 serve staggered terms.
- (i) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), in the first election

 held after January 1, 2006, in which all of the justices of the

 peace in a county are elected, the justices of the peace for

 odd-numbered precincts shall be elected to serve for a term of two

 years, and the justices of the peace for even-numbered precincts

 shall be elected to serve for a term of four years. At subsequent

 elections, the justices of the peace shall be elected for terms of
- SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

four years. This subsection expires January 1, 2009.
