- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 1-g, Article VIII, Texas
- 8 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The legislature by general law may authorize an
- 10 incorporated city or town or a county to issue bonds or notes to
- 11 finance the development or redevelopment of an unproductive,
- 12 underdeveloped, or blighted area within the city, [or] town, or
- county and to pledge for repayment of those bonds or notes increases
- 14 in ad valorem tax revenues imposed on property in the area by the
- 15 city, [or] town, county, or [and] other political subdivisions.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing
- 20 authorization for a county to issue bonds or notes to finance the
- 21 development or redevelopment of an unproductive, underdeveloped,
- or blighted area within the county."
