WHEREAS, After the death of her husband in 1935, Camerina was left with four children to raise by herself; she spent her life in Edinburg and worked hard in a variety of jobs, such as running a small grocery store, scrubbing floors in a hospital, working in a cannery, and cooking in a restaurant; and

WHEREAS, Her family, which includes her four children and 20 grandchildren, attributes Camerina's long life to her decades of hard work; the secret to her strength, she claims, is jalapeño peppers; she is known for her engaging personality, her courage, and her compassion for others; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas,
