

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 499

WHEREAS, An exemplary public servant, Chief Garwacki has handled his many responsibilities with the Murphy Police Department and the City of Murphy with exceptional efficiency and dedication, and he is admired and respected by all who know him; and

WHEREAS, Chief Garwacki deserves to be proud of his many accomplishments and of making the Murphy Police Department the professionally recognized department it is today; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 79th Legislature, hereby commend Police Chief Fred Garwacki for his many years of valuable service to the City of Murphy and extend to him best wishes for the retirement years ahead; and, be it further
