WHEREAS, She held positions in the Austin Art League and was a member of a women's book club and an investment group; she was active in many service organizations and was well known for her creative social events and her culinary and interior design skills; she was most dedicated to her family and maintained a goal of doing something special for someone every day; and

WHEREAS, Jeanne enriched the lives of all who knew her and was noted for her warmth, kindness, and sense of humor; she was a generous and highly respected woman who leaves behind memories that will be treasured forever by her family and many friends; now, therefore, be it
