**IN RE: HB93** by Riddle (Relating to showing the manner of death on the death certificate of an inmate of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice who is lawfully executed.), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to specify the cause of death in lawful executions. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice has determined that the cost of implementing the bill would not be significant.
