IN RE: HB196 by Guillen (Relating to the introduction or possession of certain items in a correctional facility; creating an offense.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code by creating the offense of contraband in correctional facility. No significant impact on the programs and workload of state corrections agencies or on the demand for resources and services of those agencies is anticipated.
