IN RE: HB209 by Goodman (Relating to rescinding an acknowledgment of paternity executed by a minor.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend Section 160.307, "Proceeding for Rescission," Chapter 160, Uniform Parentage Act, Family Code, extending the rescission period for a minor who signed an Acknowledgment of Paternity (AOP) to sixty days after the child reaches age eighteen or otherwise emancipates.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
