**IN RE: HB209** by Goodman (Relating to rescinding an acknowledgment of paternity executed by a minor.), **As Introduced** 

## No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend Section 160.307, "Proceeding for Rescission," Chapter 160, Uniform Parentage Act, Family Code, extending the rescission period for a minor who signed an Acknowledgment of Paternity (AOP) to sixty days after the child reaches age eighteen or otherwise emancipates.
