**IN RE: HB259** by Elkins (Relating to the powers of a county, municipality, or local entity with respect to the regulation of traffic on highways under its jurisdiction.), **As Introduced**

The bill would repeal the definition of "regulating" from Section 542.202 of the Transportation Code, related to traffic laws.
