**IN RE: HB348** by Chisum (Relating to limiting the authority of a property owner to erect a gate on certain third-class and neighborhood roads.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to require a person wanting to erect a gate on a third-class or neighborhood road to first obtain approval from the county commissioners court. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.

**Local Government Impact**

The county may experience minimal administrative costs.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
