**IN RE: HB356** by Callegari (Relating to the repeal of the statutory provision regarding the adoption and use by the Texas Water Development Board of a capital spending plan for certain state-funded water-related programs under the board's jurisdiction.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would remove the requirement that the Water Development Board prepare a Capital Spending Plan each year. Because the agency currently does not allocate significant resources to this activity, no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
