**IN RE: HB602** by Eissler (Relating to the designation of a weight enforcement officer by a commissioners court in certain counties. ), **As Passed 2nd House**

The bill would amend Chapter 621, Transportation Code, to authorize the county commissioners court in certain counties to designate a constable or deputy constable as a weight enforcement officer. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.

**Local Government Impact**

If a county commissioners court were to designate a constable or deputy constable as a weight enforcement officer, the county would incur the cost of training and certification for each person designated as such.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
