**IN RE: HB623** by Olivo (Relating to the right of a parent of a public school student to prompt notice of certain disciplinary action taken against the student. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require a school district to provide a parent immediate notice if their child has been removed from class for placement in a disciplinary alternative education program or juvenile justice alternative education program.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.

Anecdotal information suggests that the vast majority of districts provide timely notice to parents.
