IN RE: HB694 by Leibowitz (relating to disclosure of electronic terminal withdrawal limits; providing a civil penalty.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
