IN RE: HB751 by Thompson (Relating to an urban land bank demonstration program in certain municipalities.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would apply only to a municipality that has a population of 1.9 million or more. According to the 2000 federal census, only the City of Houston meets that criteria.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
