**IN RE: HB792** by Coleman (Relating to the use of certain rating practices in certain lines of insurance.), **As Introduced**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>
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This bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to the use of certain rating practices in certain lines of insurance. Based on the analysis of the Department of Insurance and the Office of Public Insurance Counsel, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

This bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
