IN RE: HB807 by Driver (Relating to reporting positive alcohol and drug tests of holders of commercial driver's licenses.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code relating to the reporting of positive alcohol and drug tests of holders of commercial driver's licenses. Under current law, the requirement that employers report positive drug test results to the Department of Public Safety is codified in Section 643.064, Transportation Code. The bill would move that section to Transportation Code, Section 644.252. The Department of Public Safety reports that there would not be any additional responsibilities for recordkeeping.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
