IN RE: HB845 by Krusee (Relating to certain standards applicable to the temporary confinement of certain inmates in holding areas located in county facilities.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to prohibit the Commission on Jail Standards from adopting or enforcing a rule that establishes minimum standards relating to the temporary confinement of inmates in holding areas located in county facilities other than a county jail or correctional facility. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
