**IN RE: HB858** by Kolkhorst (Relating to the issuance of a marriage license to applicants who are unable to personally appear before the county clerk.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Family Code regarding when a county clerk may or may not issue a marriage license when both applicants are unable to appear in person. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005 and would apply only to marriage license applications filed on or after that date.
