IN RE: HB907 by Campbell (Relating to the membership of the Critical Infrastructure Protection Council.), **As Introduced**

The bill adds the Texas Water Development Board as a member of the Critical Infrastructure Protection Council. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives the requisite two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2005.
