**IN RE: HB934** by Taylor (Relating to notice requirements in certain proceedings relating to charitable trusts. ), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

This bill would change the time period for notice to the Attorney General on a proceeding involving a charitable trust from within 30 days of the filing of a pleading, but no less than 10 days to within 30 days of the filing of a pleading, but no less than 25 business days.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
