**IN RE: HB960** by Smith, Wayne (Relating to the authority of a political subdivision to regulate construction and renovation of structures owned by certain counties.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would apply to a building or facility that is owned by a county with a population of 3.3 million or more and is located within the boundaries of another political subdivision. As of the 2000 federal census, the population criteria would apply only to Harris County.

**Local Government Impact**

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
