**IN RE: HB1036** by Rose (Relating to conflicts of interest of policy board members of metropolitan planning organizations; providing a criminal penalty.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code by specifying that regulations of conflict of interest addressed in Chapter 171, Local Government Code, would apply to policy board members of a metropolitan planning organization. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
