IN RE: HB1036 by Rose (Relating to conflicts of interest of policy board members of metropolitan planning organizations; providing a criminal penalty.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code by specifying that regulations of conflict of interest addressed in Chapter 171, Local Government Code, would apply to policy board members of a metropolitan planning organization. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
