IN RE: HB1037 by Isett (Relating to the prosecution of the offense of unlawfully carrying a handgun, illegal knife, or club.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code to continue exceptions to the prosecution of individuals for the offense of unlawfully carrying a weapon. The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.
