IN RE: HB1120 by Nixon (Relating to information required to be included in an application for a marriage license and an affidavit of an absent applicant for a marriage license; providing a criminal penalty.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill proposes additional statements to the affidavit that is to be completed for a marriage license. Aggravated perjury under this section would be classified as a Class A misdemeanor.
