IN RE: HB1186 by Hartnett (Relating to testamentary and nontestamentary transfers of property and other benefits.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would prohibit devises or bequests of property in a will to certain relatives of an attorney who prepared the will. This bill would make various amendments and additions to the law of testamentary and non-testamentary transfers.
