IN RE: HB1366 by Allen, Ray (Relating to the regulation of nursing.), **As Passed 2nd House**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Board of Nurse Examiners and State Office of Administrative Hearings indicate that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
