**IN RE: HB1379** by Jones, Jesse (Relating to the admissibility in a civil action of certain information relating to identify theft.), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would make a business record that was provided to a member of a law enforcement agency regarding an investigation of an identity theft violation inadmissible in a civil action.
