**IN RE: HB1379** by Jones, Jesse (Relating to the admissibility in a civil action of certain information relating to identify theft.), **As Introduced**

The bill would make communications by a seller of goods or services to a member of a law enforcement agency regarding an investigation of an identity theft violation inadmissible in a civil action.
