IN RE: HB1472 by Casteel (Relating to the authority to file an application for the creation of a management trust during a guardianship proceeding.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would permit any person interested in the welfare of an incapacitated person to apply for the creation of a management trust for the benefit of the incapacitated person. Under current law, only a ward's guardian, a ward's attorney ad litem, and an incapacitated person's guardian ad litem may make such an application.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
