**IN RE: HB1628** by Brown, Betty (Relating to the authority of certain counties to enact noise regulations; providing a criminal penalty.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize certain counties to enact noise regulations and would establish that a violation of those regulations would be a Class C misdemeanor. Based on the two most recent federal decennial censuses, the parameters of the bill would apply only to Kaufman and Harris counties.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
