IN RE: HB1628 by Brown, Betty (Relating to the authority of certain counties to enact noise regulations; providing a criminal penalty.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would authorize certain counties to enact noise regulations and would establish that a violation of those regulations would be a Class C misdemeanor. Based on the two most recent federal decennial censuses, the parameters of the bill would apply only to Kaufman and Harris counties.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
