IN RE: HB1647 by Hughes (Relating to the appointment of a campaign treasurer and the filing of reports by a political party's county executive committee that accepts or makes a certain amount of political contributions or expenditures.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would increase the aggregate amount for political contributions that would require that a county executive committee file a campaign treasurer appointment and certain reports; therefore, the bill would apply only to requirements for political parties, not a governmental entity.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
