**IN RE: HB1649** by Luna (Relating to the regulation of interior designers; providing penalties.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the regulation of interior designers. Since the Texas Board of Architectural Examiners participates in the Self-Directed, Semi-Independent program, any fiscal impact would be to the agency's operating fund held outside the state treasury.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2005.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
